

Connecting classrooms around the world to encourage intercultural communication and create a better tomorrow.





Teachers and students are able to create profiles to showcase their classroom and culture to the world.


















Classes are able to search and connect with other classrooms around the world based on age, location and demographic.

















CONNECT









EARN ° POINTS°

Classrooms earn points and badges for all engagement between their students and partner classes.

















Points are accumulated and able to be donated by each class to different impact campaigns that look to benefit under resourced schools around the world.














TEACHER ADMIN PANEL

Additionally, teachers have a direct overview of their class through their dashboard. This dashboard provides valuable insights into their class and individual student activity, along with access to each of their students interactions with matched partners.




Meet Bronwyn. Bronwyn is a Grade 3/4 teacher in Australia. She is an advocate for global education and is focused on providing her students the opportunity to learn outside of the four walls of the classroom. However, living in Australia makes it difficult to collaborate with other countries based on time zones alone.


Eager to connect her students, Bronwyn registered for Belouga and had her class of 26 students create profiles.



Six weeks into using Belouga, Bronwyn and her 26 students have been extremely active on the platform. In total, they have now connected with 27 other classes around the world, earning a total of 23,130 points. Having seen great excitement out of her students, Bronwyn shared the platform with two coworkers in her school. Her coworkers and their 49 students end up connecting with a total of 17 classes worldwide, earning a total of 20,880 points in just three weeks!

Thanks to the support and daily usage by teachers like Bronwyn, Belouga is able to make a major difference in creating global citizens and building humanitarian skills.

In total, Bronwyn and her co-teachers earned 44,010 points and ended up donating their points to a campaign supporting a school in Kenya called The Cheery Children's Education Centre. The school is a small educational institution offering humanitarian assistance and caring for the needs of the poverty stricken children in Nairobi's Kibera slum, the largest slum in Africa by population and size.

The campaign goal of 166,000 points was achieved in December 2016 and triggered a donation of tablets to the school to give them the opportunity to enhance their education and connect to the world.



After receiving the tablets, students at The Cheery Children's Education Centre wanted to connect with classes that supported their campaign and they took the initiative to create profiles on Belouga.

Even better, these student ended up connecting and earning points for their participation, which were then donated to another Impact Campaign supporting a school in need.



THE BELOUGA IMPACT

The Belouga Impact portal showcases partner schools in need of support. that lack the everyday resources needed to provide their students with the best educational experience. Whether it be a lack of technology access, minimal classroom supplies or raw materials needed to build a new facility, Belouga is determined to lend a hand.
